Measures Taken by the National-Level Committee on Resettlement and Closure of IDP Camps

Objective

To foster enduring peace which is fundamental requirement for rule of law, socio-economic development, national unity and internal peace and emergence of a Union based on democracy and federalism by ensuring safety, dignity and independently long-term settlement in the original places for the IDPs in some of the conflict affected areas and closure of IDP Camps.

Implementation Process for the Resettlement and Closure of IDP Camps

The National-Level Committee on Resettlement and Closure of IDP Camps is implementing in accordance with the following processes:

1. Establishment of Work Committees;
2. Establishment of State-Level Committees;
3. Establishment of State-Level Work Committees;
4. Holding Coordination Meetings of the National-Level Committee; and
5. Implementing the decisions of the National-Level Committee Meetings.

Formation of National-Level Committee

The State Administrative Council started to form the National-Level Committee on Resettlement and Closure of IDP Camps with the Notification No. (66/2021) dated 21-3-2021 and amended with Notification No. (49/2024) dated 27-2-2024 and Notification No. (88/2024) dated 8-5-2024 as follows:

5. State-Level Work Committee on Information.

Ranking for the Provision of Resettlement

Ranking for the provision of resettlement as follows:

1. Those who want to return to their original places of residences as the First Priority.
2. Those who want to move to a new place such as other towns, villages and relatives with their own arrangements as the Second Priority.
3. Those who want to move new villages as the Third Priority.

Provision for the construction of houses

Provision suitable amount of money for construction of displaced persons' houses based on the condition of damage to their houses as follows:

1. House that was completely destroyed based on the level (A, B, or C) of their original houses.
2. House that was damaged based on the level (A, B, or C) of their original houses.

Construction or renovation works will be implemented as Cash for Work Programme.

National-Level Committee Chairman's Inspection Tours
